- **Module 2: Risk Assessment and Hazard Controls**
  - Entry conditions and hazard identification
  - Atmospheric testing, ventilation, PPE, and control measures
  - Planning for abnormal and emergency scenarios
- **Module 3: Permit-to-Work and Documentation**
  - Issuing and authorizing safe work permits
  - Roles: entrant, attendant, supervisor
  - Recordkeeping and permit audits
- **Module 4: Workshop - Confined Space Entry Simulation**
  - Participants complete a mock risk assessment and permit
  - Instructor feedback and best practice discussion
