- Module 3: Choking and Breathing Emergencies (11:30 - 01:00) • Heimlich maneuver (adult/child/infant) • Rescue breathing techniques
- Module 4: Certification Assessment & Wrap-Up (02:00 - 03:30) • Hands-on skills test and written quiz • Feedback, certification awarding, and closing
